- > An official transcript (unopened) with a school seal.
- ➤ 2 letters of recommendation from a Teacher, Guidance Counselor, Principal, Mentor Supervisor, Pastor, or B-CU Alumni.
- ➤ A 2-Page Essay (12 pt. font) to include one of the following topics:
- "Why is Accomplishing a College Education Important to Me?"
- "Why I chose Bethune-Cookman University?"

#5- Proof of community service or volunteer hours.
#6- A copy of a FASFA Financial Aid Eligibility Letter.
#7- Letter of Acceptance to Bethune-Cookman University.
#8- Two letters of recommendation.
#9- A 2-Page (12 font) essay on "Why is Accomplishing a College Education Important to Me?" or "Why I chose Bethune-Cookman University?" Note: Please have a Teacher, Guidance Counselor, Parent/Guardian, or Mentor proofread your essay to prevent grammatical/spelling errors.
