Eligibility:

The scholarship is open to high school seniors who will graduate from a Duval County public high school in spring 2020. Five winners will receive a one-year meal plan scholarship to be applied towards their post-secondary education at a historically black college and university.

Requirements:

- Acceptance letter/proof of enrollment into a historically black college and university
 - Only the schools listed above will be accepted
- Submit a copy of official high school transcript
 - 2.5 GPA or above
- Submit completed application
- Submit essay response (1000 words or less)
