

Three Rivers Council Scholarship Application

The Three Rivers Council (TRC) of the JAX Chamber is pleased to offer a \$1,000 college scholarship to a deserving high school student for the 2022-23 school year!

Requirements to qualify:

- You must have a connection to the TRC (formerly West or North Council) region of Jacksonville, west of the St Johns River: either you live, attend school or one of your parents works in the demographic area.
- You must have a cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.0.
- You must be enrolled to attend an accredited two or four-year college in the fall of 2022.
- You must complete this application in full, including a one-page essay about why you should be awarded the scholarship.
- The application must be completed in this Word format (take as much room as you like to answer) and emailed to Barbara Vick at <u>bvick@keiseruniversity.edu</u> by May 15, 2022.

If selected, you must provide your high school transcript (or other proof of your graduation/GPA), proof of your SAT/ACT score(s) and proof of your college acceptance.

In addition, you must choose to attend one of the following TRC events in July or August to meet our members, introduce yourself and tell us about your college plans:

- Lunch with Leaders
- Wake Up on the Westside Breakfast

The scholarship will be awarded in two parts: \$500 for the fall semester and \$500 for the spring semester.

In order to receive the spring semester award, you will need to provide proof that you earned at least a 2.5 GPA for the fall semester and that you completed at least 12 semester hours. The money will be deposited into the student's account at the college.
